Wednesday 30th April 2025

We are planning to take the children to Go Ape at Leeds Castle for a day of outdoor pursuits. This school visit is designed to enhance social skills and team building within the outdoor learning environment. The date will be Wednesday 11th June.

The children will need to arrive at school promptly as we will be leaving at 9.15am and returning to school for the usual departure time of 3.05pm.

This will be an invaluable experience, not to be missed and will be something for both classes to look forward to after their forthcoming SATs tests in May. This will be a really fun, adventurous day where children will be able to take on ambitious challenges, showing resilience and support for one another.

The cost of the trip has been subsidised by the 'Sports Funding' reducing the cost to £23.50 per child. The price covers the cost of two workshops and travel. While contributions are voluntary, they help cover the costs of wider opportunities. No pupil will be excluded if their parents/carers are unable to pay. If the weather is poor, we will ask the children to wear a rain coat also, however, this will be determined nearer the time.
